TEVIS ANNOUNCES CANDIDACY FOR CITY COUNCIL AT ANTI-TAX DAY RALLY

Amid a large crowd of supporters at Alameda Park in Santa Barbara, Justin Tevis announced his candidacy for Santa Barbara City Council.

Tevis spoke on the themes of limited government, freedom, and the power of the people to manage the growth of government at all levels. And that starts with controlling the “nanny council” we have in Santa Barbara, Tevis said. Tevis reminded the audience: “We are the check on the government’s power.”

“Our government has become lost in the ‘Candyland’ of the people’s money, and the time has come to cut-off the government’s sweet-tooth,” Tevis roared over an exuberant crowd.

A native to Santa Barbara County and a resident of the City of Santa Barbara, Tevis played on the Santa Barbara County All-Star Football Team and was a varsity athlete at Claremont McKenna College. Tevis brings that same commitment and enthusiasm to his bid for office.

Tevis told his audience, “We need to march the liberty ball down the field for a touchdown this coming election day.”

Tevis filed his intention to run for Santa Barbara City Council today with the Santa Barbara City Clerk’s office. The City Council election is scheduled for November 3, 2009.
